Enrollment Policy for students with ISP/IEP

This policy is to make families aware of what accommodations can be made for students with an ISP/IEP. As a private school, CCS is not required to follow modification lists fully or modify the instruction to the class for the needs of a single student. We are willing to accommodate ISP/IEP students when modifications are not an impediment to the class as a whole or the workload of a teacher. Please review and sign the listed policy.

- No special education services will be provided
- Work may be modified
- Grades will be given based on percentage of problems completed correctly
- Parents are responsible for obtaining/providing any outside tutoring and/or resources the student may need
- If student fails two or more core subjects, student will be retained
- At the discretion of a teacher, if a student is unable to complete daily work at the pace of the class, work may be sent home for completion

Possible Modifications

1. Decreasing number of problems given
2. Providing charts and/or resources
3. Students may read material ahead of time with a parent.
4. Papers may be sent home to be corrected to learn the missed concepts; however, grades will remain the same.
