JOG-A-THON SCHEDULE!



DRESS CODE REWARD WEEK IS NEXT WEEK: April 24-April 28: ALL students who RAISED \$150 or more will receive Free Dress Code for the week. (See "Free Dress Code" guidelines in the CCS Handbook.) WINNERS are posted in the HS office, Middle School office, and outside the PTSF office. Students need to check the list to know if they qualified.

JOG-A-THON DAY!!!! NEXT FRIDAY, APRIL 28: ALL JOG-A-THON PARTICIPANTS SHOULD BE DROPPED OFF AT THE CCS FOOTBALL FIELD/ACTIVITY CENTER (5300 N. Interstate Drive.) Please see below for required arrival times. NOTE: Before-care students will be transported to the activity center.

- Student DRIVERS MUST arrive and be parked at the activity center by 7:45am!
- 6th -12th grade students need to arrive and check in with their 2nd hour teacher between 8:00-8:15am.
- EVERYONE (Parents, younger siblings are WELCOME) will run, jog, walk, tumble, skip, hop, etc. around the football field for 30 min. **beginning at 8:45!** This FUN event will end by 9:30am. Students are free to leave after they check out with their teacher. **ALL STUDENTS SHOULD BE PICKED UP AT THE ACTIVITY CENTER BY 9:30AM.** Students who are not picked up by 9:30 will be transported back to the school and should be picked up NO LATER THAN 11:30AM. There will be NO lunches served and NO after-care.

STUDENTS WHO ARE NOT PARTICIPATING...

- Students who are not participating in the jog-a-thon are required to be at school at the regular time and MUST be picked up by 11:30am. NO lunches and NO after-care. NOTE!! If you missed your chance to ask for sponsors, or just got busy and forgot, there is STILL time to turn in a \$20 donation if your student would like to participate in this FUN day.
