ANNUAL BOARD MEETING-Monday, May 20, AT 6:30 PM

As parents of children at CCS, you are a member of the corporation, Community Christian School, Inc. As a corporation, the annual meeting will be held Monday, May 20, 2019 for the purpose of electing Board Members, voting on revision to the by-laws, and hearing the administrator's report regarding the past year, with projections for the year to come. The CCS By-laws that govern the structure and operation of the CCS school board were written in 1986, and have not been amended or updated in over 20 years. The board is recommending three amendments to the current by-laws to update and adjust terminology, communication and the flow of board meetings. The three amendments were emailed to all CCS families on April 29. This give you a chance to read the amendments before the board meeting. A copy of these amendments will also be available at the May 20th annual board meeting. These amendments will be voted upon at the May 20th board meeting.

THE HIGH SCHOOL ARCHERY TEAM HAS RETURNED FROM NATIONALS!

The High School competed in the Eastern Nationals in Louisville, Kentucky. What a great experience! Ten of the 19 archers who competed either tied or beat their previous high score. Our top male scorer was Jonathan King, who scored 285 out of a possible 300 points. This placed him in the top 7% of 9th grade boys, top 9% of all high school boys, and top 5% of all boys. Our top female scorer was Savannah Tedford, who scored 281 out of a possible 300. She placed in the top 6% of 10th grade girls, top 9% of high school girls, and top 5% of all girls. Individual scores: Brianna Calvin-281, George Gillum-278, Alli Wilson-277, Anneli Walsh-276, Braden Bone-272, Payton Calfy- 271, Raegan Beggs-269, Hope Shelton-269, Rosalind Scott-265, Jeannine Bowen-263, Alex Shuman-260, Keeli Morris-258, Sydney Ward-257, Anna Ledford-250, Megan Speed-250, Konnor Richardson-249, and Madeline Waggoner-247. The team placed 105 out of 263 high school teams, and 16 of the archers made the Academic Archer team. Most importantly, several of the team members had an opportunity to witness to a few people.
