***MARLOW MEET-August 28:** JH Girls-Bethany Jeffries-1st Place and Preslee Hartssock-6th place out of 52 runners.

JH Boys: Keaton Cochell lead the Royals, placing 6th out of 51 competitors.

8th and 9th grade Girls Race: Alissa Henry-10th place out of 56 runners. **8th and 9th Boys Race:** Trenton Weber-1st place, Josh Pantoja-2nd place leading the 73 runners. **Boys Varsity:** CJ Haynes (10th)-7th place out of 89 runners. HSJV Boys were among 68 runners, our Varsity Girls were among 84 runners and our HSJV Girls were among 43 runners. All competed well.

***WATONGA MEET-September 1:** This was a large meet so the top 30 in each category took home medals.
