

SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY: First and foremost, students are encouraged to always exercise the utmost caution when participating in any form of social media or online communications. Students who participate in online interactions must remember that their posts reflect on everyone associated with Community Christian School and, as such, these interactions are subject to the same behavioral standards set forth in the Student Handbook. In addition to the regulations found in the Student Handbook, students are expected to abide by the following: Students may not use social media sites to publish disrespectful, disparaging or harassing remarks about CCS staff or faculty, students, parents, relatives, athletic or academic contest rivals, etc. Students who choose to post editorial content to websites or other forms of online media must ensure that their submission does not reflect poorly upon the school or other students. Failure to abide by this Social Media Policy, as with other policies at CCS, will result in disciplinary action as described in the Student Handbook, or as determined by the Administrator.
