

WHAT TO BRING

Personal Items These are the things you don't want to go without! Remember: the community we work doesn't have a Wal-Mart close by, so be sure to double check what you have packed!

- SINGLE Air Mattress (except Bahamas)
- Sleeping Bag or Bedding
- Pillow
- Towel
- Toilet Articles (soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush)
- Work Clothes (old jeans/shorts, tee shirts,- no spaghetti strap tank tops)
- Raincoat
- Closed-toe shoes
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen
- Insect Repellent
- Snacks
- Bible
- Passport

Participants are not allowed to have telephones or other electronic devices once we arrive in Haiti. If you desire to take pictures, please take a camera. We will have an assigned photographer and pictures and a video will be available following the trip.

Personal Tools These items are a must! Most projects will require safety glasses and work gloves. Please ask your students to clearly mark these items with their name and the name of your church. If students are interested in leaving these items on site as a donation, please let us know!
