JOG-A-THON 2023 SCHEDULE

****JOG-A-THON WILL BE HELD AT THE ACTIVITY CENTER, NOT the Main Campus!
NO CLASSES AFTER EVENT AND NO AFTERCARE or LUNCHES.**

6TH-12TH Grade Schedule:

- ALL Students report to the Activity Center, on the Football Field at 7:50 (regular school time)
- Students will check in with their Bible teacher as they enter the football field.
- 6th-12th grades will jog from 7:50-8:20. Students will be dismissed at 8:20 (drivers and pick-up line)
- A pick-up line will be along the south side of the gym. Driving students will be dismissed to cars and leave.
- Driving students should park on the south side of the parking lot closest to the Baseball Field.
- 6th - 12th grade students who are waiting for elementary siblings to jog will wait in the bleachers

PK-5TH GRADE Schedule:

- All students will report to the ACTIVITY CENTER inside the GYM at regular class time. Students should enter through the south doors of the gym (main doors). Students will check in with their HOMEROOM teacher inside the gym and be seated with their class on the bleachers.
- SPIRIT ASSEMBLY FROM 8:10 – 8:40!! We have some fun activities planned and will announce the SPIRIT AWARD, the grade with the highest fundraising participation and the grade with the most school spirit at the assembly! - A pick-up line will begin at 9:20 along the south side of the gym.
- If the parking lot is full, parents may drop off students and wait for the JH/HS students to be dismissed at 8:20 and then park in the newly open spots.
- **Students who need to stay will be bussed back to the Elementary building. ALL STUDENTS MUST be picked up by 11:00 am! NO AFTERCARE and NO LUNCHES!**
- We will have regular before-care. Before-care students who are participating will be bussed to the activity center at 7:50 for the Jog-a-thon.
