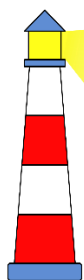

A MESSAGE FROM DEPUTY ERIC! Reminder for parents of new student drivers:

Students who have passed the driving skills exam, and received their license, will have an Intermediate Restriction G license for the first 6 months. This restricts the driver to 1 passenger OR only people who live in the driver's home, OR any passenger if accompanied in the front seat by a licensed driver at least 21 years old. This restriction is from 5:00 am to 11:00 pm unless for activities related to work, church, or school.
