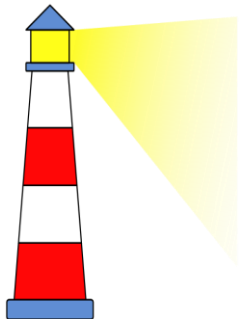
ENGLISH & SCIENCE FINALS (after lunch)-9th-12th grade students (and 8th graders in HS classes)
